


A registered user is in their workspace and clicks "My Companies/Workspace" from either the top bar or the "Change" from the lefthand menu

The third CTA column isn't functionally possible with the database at this point.


## Notes:

The company row links to the company workspace


The user can also use the search bar to pull up the company. Lefthand menus


"Company/Workspace" and "Connection" disappear and the Profile menu expands.



The user clicks "Add a Company" button and the Add a Company form appears.


The form will behave as it does on the registration page.

The company's icon colours are automatically assigned.




PENDING:

Red Messaging/CTA TBD

At this point, users can only create new accounts. When the user selects the company that already has a Verus360 account, messaging appears.

The Submit button is deactivated (grayed out) but the user can hit cancel and return to the My Companies screen.



Multiple Companies impacts the Settings area. When the user is in "My Companies / Workspaces mode," and selects the profile icon on the top, the user cannot access the "Company Settings", so it will be hidden from the menu.

We will also place all the Settings in a collapsible left hand menu rather than replacing the entire column as it currently does and remove the "back to the workspace" link.'
